Memory loss affects everybody. Some of us assess ourselves and/or our loved ones for early signs of memory loss. Many of us do or will worry that a dementia diagnosis is in our future.

On Thursday, November 18th from 2:00 – 3:30 pm, Granite Falls Living at Home Block Nurse Program, in partnership with other local organizations, will present a virtual Remember Project event featuring Fortune Cookies by Bonnie Dudovitz. This play tells the story of Mona, a spunky and mentally fit octogenarian who has cooked up a plan to keep her mind and memories intact. Her adult son David stops over for a visit, learns about Mona’s plan, and has some questions.

Join our efforts to raise awareness and fight the stigma and fear of memory loss. Watch the short play, participate in a facilitated conversation about the play and the Dementia Friendly Communities movement, learn about Granite Falls area dementia-friendly resources, and meet others who are also interested in learning more about dementia and its’ impact.
